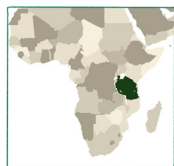


TANZANIA



Coffees from Tanzania are grown in the Southern Highlands region, and on the hillsides of the majestic Mount Kilimanjaro and Mt. Meru. The Farmer Support Center is located in Mbeya, the southwest region of the country. Similar to agronomists in neighboring countries, the focus is on improving coffee tree productivity, mitigating the effects of climate change (increased temperatures and changes in rainfall patterns), and helping farmers improve the quality of coffee. By offering training sessions, farmers better understand the quality of their coffee in the cup, and how to improve it.
