

Malawi is a small, landlocked country in southeast Africa bordering Mozambique, Zambia and Tanzania. It is one of the most densely populated countries on the continent and split by the Great Rift Valley and the vast Lake Malawi. High plateaus and rolling hills span the country with a mix of smallholder coffee farms and large estates.

Farmers in Malawi are supported by the Starbucks Farmer Support Center (FSC) in Tanzania. The focus is on the sustainability of farms, improving coffee tree productivity, and mitigating the effects of climate change.
