



MALAWI



Malawi is a landlocked country in southeast Africa, where it borders Mozambique, Zambia and Tanzania. It sits along the Great Rift Valley and vast Lake Malawi; high plateaus and rolling hills span the country with a mix of smallholder coffee farms and large estates. Malawi is also one of the most densely populated countries on the continent. It is nicknamed “The Warm Heart of Africa” due to the friendliness of its people. The country is also one of the world’s least-developed countries, and its economy is heavily dependent on agriculture.

Farmers in Malawi are supported by the Starbucks Farmer Support Center (FSC) in Tanzania. The focus is on improving coffee tree productivity and mitigating the effects of climate change. By offering training sessions, farmers better understand the quality of their cup and how to improve it.
